Chamber of Commerce.

In April, Don Moffitt, State Representative, was our speaker and updated us on progress for the state of Illinois.

Session resumes on Tuesday April 29th, 2014. The deadline to get bills to com-

mittee is May 16th. The deadline to pass bills in the house is May 23rd. The bills go to the Governor next. They adjourn May 31st.

Bill 4609 sponsored by Sarah Fagaholz would increase requirements for new construction of homes & apartments. The Illinois Fire Marshall will not be able to mandate the requirement of sprinkler systems.

A Minimum Wage increase to \$10 is being proposed and it is also being considered on the national level.

They are considering having Property Taxes fund State Pensions. The budget will be difficult because they have to estimate 951 Million Dollars less if taxes go away.

Don Moffitt will consider voting for the Capital Bills as it will fund new highways, bridges, and repairs.

He would like to get a new passenger rail from the Quad cities to Galesburg. It would help strengthen our corridor. It would allow access to 20 colleges.

Please remember to attend the Membership Meeting on May 21st at 6:30p.m. at the Kensington.





Building Safety Month

Galesburg, IL (May 6, 2014) On May 5, 2014, Mayor John Pritchard proclaimed the month of May 2014 as **Building Safety Month.** Honestly building safety should be highlighted every month, week and day of the year.

Keeping the buildings that we live, work and play in safe is a daily goal for the International Code Council (ICC) and the inspectors tasked to review the construction process from the initial design phase all the way to completion.

The theme of this year's Building Safety Month is "Building Safety: Maximizing Resilience, Minimizing Risks." By building a safe and resilient home, deck, garage, office building or any other structure from the start will result in longer lasting and higher quality construction.

The goal of these construction codes, which include, Residential, Commercial Building, Plumbing, Electrical, Fuel Gas, Accessibility and Fire, is to prevent injury and loss of life. One death, even just one injury, due to a structural failure or fire is one too many.

Each week in May will feature a specific safety theme. This week is "Keeping Fire in its Place." The following weeks will feature these topics: "Helping Homeowners Weather the Storm," "Surround Your Building with Safety" and "Building a Brighter, More Efficient Tomorrow."

Throughout this month, the Community Development Department will have fliers, handouts and other items for all ages that promote building safety.

All brochures and fliers are complements of ICC and provided free of charge to the City and Public. There are also pencils and stickers available, while they last, which have been provided by the Community Development Inspectors at no cost to the City or Public.

Please join the City and Inspectors as we celebrate building safety and work toward building a brighter and safer tomorrow.




2014 WIBA Annual Golf Outing Hole Sponsorship
