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

Thank you if you have already registered for the WIBA Home Show with Terry Hartley. If you have not and want to do so, contact him soon to see if he has a space for you.


We will be talking about advertising for the Home Show at the next WIBA Membership Meeting.

Julie King National Railroad Hall of Fame Engines of Freedom WIBA Membership Meeting January 20, 2016



The National Railroad Hall of Fame will tell the great American story of the people who have built the railroad. The Master Plan is complete, The Business Plan has been updated, and the Market Study is in progress. The Capital Campaign funded working on the design detail, biddable documents, and scripts for movies. Construction is estimated to take 18 months to 2 years.

BRC Arts is designing the museum. It will be interactive and entertaining. They designed the Lincoln Museum in Springfield. The advisor for the project is Brett Glass, PHD. He is the Director of the National Museum of American History of the Smithsonian Institute. Skidwell, Owings, & Merrill is the chosen architectural firm from Chicago. The Tom Leader Studio from Berkley, California is the Landscape Architect.

On the outside of the National Railroad Hall of Fame, it will feature an over the track observation bridge, a separate outdoor amphitheater, a rail artifact walk, and a walk of fame of inductees, and a separate bus parking lot.

Inside the National Railroad Hall of Fame , it will feature Central Station with a clock tower & 3 different scales of trains running on tracks, an 1850 First Golden Age Visitor's Center, a Main Gallery featuring people, and the Today & Tomorrow which will demonstrate how a railroad operates. The theater indoors will feature "What's in Those Cars? Anything You Can Dream." The movie will show all the goods that typically are transported by rail. There will also be a flexible exhibit space for traveling exhibits and an Education Center. A large viewing area at cab height of the tracks will be available.

In 2016, they have focused on raising funds from donors of a million dollars and up. In 2017, they will focus on \$250,000 donors. When 25% of such funds are in the bank, construction should begin in 2018. They are planning the Grand Opening in 2020.

Matt Rose from BNSF has been extremely instrumental and helpful with his expertise and contacts.

This will be funded on private funding and not state funding. You will still be able to travel under the underpass just not on the Seminary Street side.

11. Attend a Home Show

Have a wonder around relevant trade shows and see what's out there. The likelihood is that you will have ad hoc conversations with delegates and exhibitors and most certainly you will learn something new.

12. Use your email signature

Make it easy to your clients to get in touch with you by having all your contact information as part of your signature. If possible, add links to your social media accounts and use your signature to highlight any news your clients might be interested in.

13. Look for speaking opportunities

Keep an eye out for industry events and see if you can put yourself forward as a speaker. Being a speaker is great for your personal and business' branding – especially if you are a good speaker and can make a good impression.

14. Don't be afraid to experiment

Keep your eyes open and test new, innovative ways to promote your business.
