Work is supposed to begin again in February on the East Main St. Underpass. It should be open in June. The paving is scheduled to be poured in March with a composite pavement. Gravel has already been laid. It will have concrete on the bottom and then asphalt. The Underpass has 16 ft. clearance.

There are 3 lift pump stations in cement chambers 25 ft. deep. They hit a lot of rock to get the chambers in place. They work like a sump pump moving excess water during storms. There is a backup generator. All the drainage will be split in two directions as before to Chambers St. and to Lincoln St. to Cedar Fork.

A precast fascia board that says WELCOME to GALESBURG has already been installed. The words will be stained in black to stand out more.

Black, decorative fence will be installed as well as decorative, black lampposts to match all the other new bridges. The pilings supporting the bridge will have concrete added with rocks. The sidewalks will be 11 ft. wide. And lighting will also be added to the underside of the underpass.

Allens Ave. has been opened up again. The traffic signals are operational on Broad St. and Carl Sandburg Drive. The timing of the lights is being studied so that it can be adjusted.

The IPEA has granted \$2,000,000 for the replacement of lead service water lines. 370 lines have been replaced so far. By February it should be 400 completed. Another 475 lead service water lines will be replaced beginning March-April and another \$2,000,000 in funds will be released in 2019 for another 500.

The city has a grant from the state for \$500,000 to replace & mitigate lead in homes. It will help with replacing door and window molding as well as siding if it has been painted with lead paint. They are applying for a $2\frac{1}{2}$ million dollar grant from H.U.D. for mitigation for 125 homes also.

The City Council has approved a bond to repair brick streets. Jefferson St. from North St. to Losey St., Silver St. from Main St. to Summit St. will be repaired. The Maple Ave. sidewalk that has suddenly crumbled is getting replaced to make it easier for the neighborhood but also all the students walking to Churchill for school. East Berrien St. off of Henderson St., Lombard St off of Brooks St., and South St. off of Oak St. will all have brick repairs.

Parking lot E behind Coney Island and Cherry St. Restaurant will have 8 spaces added and the Park Plaza will have the bowl filled in and will have landscaping and lighting added.

There will be a new Quiet Zones in front of St. Pat's Church and on Mulberry St. in front of Discovery Depot when Main St is opened up again this year.

Traffic signals at Fremont & Seminary Streets and also Farnham & Main Streets will have a yellow turn arrow added for safety.

Farnham Street will be closed for bridge replacement. The detour will be on Whitesboro St. which is currently under brick repair but will be finished by May.

The city has 3 Housing Grants to help remedy code violations and make repairs for 8-9 homes each.

The Comprehensive Plan for the city should be done in April.
