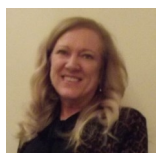

Becky King, the lead ag lender at First Midwest Bank serves as the president of the Knox County Farm Bureau and recently went to Washington D.C to represent the farmers.

Other employees serve the Knoxville Public Library Board, the Tyson Twitchell Run, as the FISH Treasurer, with food drives, running events and many other ways.

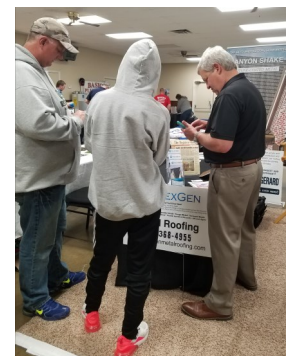
