Another option is to call **811**. 811 is now a federally-mandated number designated by the FCC to consolidate all local “Call Before You Dig” numbers and help save lives by minimizing damages to underground utilities. Underground pipelines and utility lines are marked for free. When you call 811 from anywhere in the country, your call will be routed to your state One-Call Center. Knoxville Clean Up Days



City of Knoxville, Illinois

Spring clean-up will be held for Knoxville April 12th – 15th, 2021. During this time an unlimited number of bags will be accepted on regular collection days. Materials in bags / cans are not to exceed 32 gallons in capacity or 50 pounds in weight.

For one week only - other items too large for bags can be set out on your regular garbage day with a maximum of 15 items. Items should be in a separate pile. Items longer than 6 feet or weigh more than 50 pounds must be reduced in length / weight except appliances, hot water heaters, grills, lawn mowers, etc.

The City will not collect any building material, which includes, but not limited to, shingles, bricks, concrete blocks, dry wall, lumber, or insulation. Other materials that will not be collected include wet paint (must be dried out), tires, or other hazardous materials. **NO MOTOR OIL** and **NO** large demolition waste.

Other items not collected due to landfill requirements includes electronic items; televisions, monitors, printers, computers (including tablet computers), electronic keyboards, facsimile machines, videocassette recorders, portable digital music players, digital video disc players, video game consoles, small scale servers, scanners, electronic mice, digital converter boxes, cable receivers, satellite receivers and digital video disc recorders.

Limit your output to a pickup truck size amount

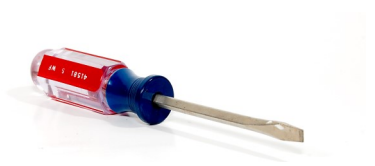

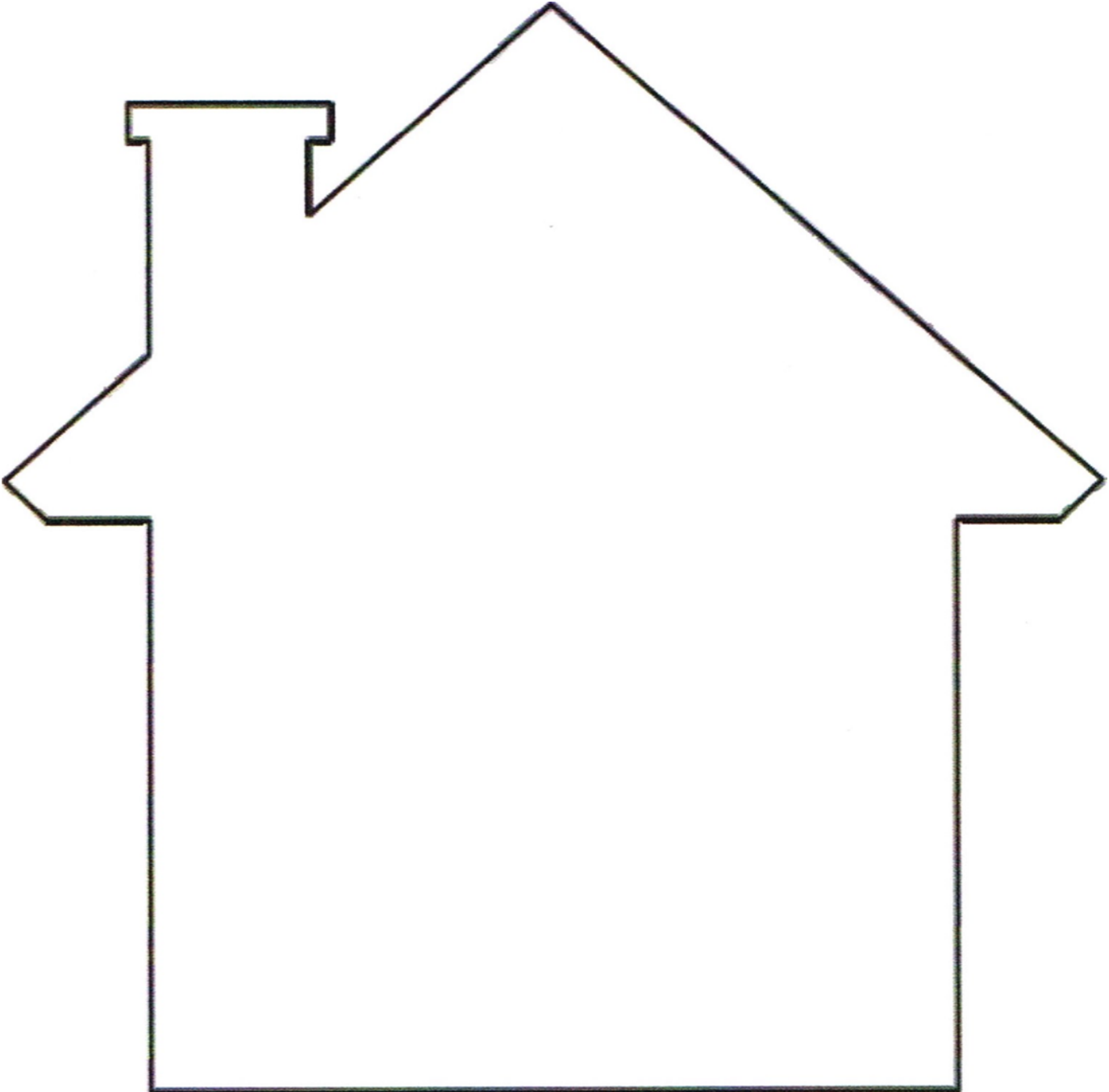

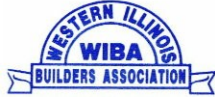
