WIBA Membership Meeting October 20, 2021

Dirk Lefler, Workforce Office of Western Illinois, was our speaker. He serves nine counties. Western Illinois Works is another name for their program. His office works in partnership with the state of Illinois. The grant is made possible through the WIO, Worker Information & Opportunity Act. It provides training for those returning to the workforce. It helps pay the salary on a sliding scale. It helps the worker who needs retraining due to a business shutdown, or even for an existing employee to upgrade their skills through training.

Dirk is a Business services Specialist for the Apprenticeship Illinois program. This is for any nonunion businesses for any job that takes more than a year or more to become proficient. He gave examples about a program that was set up for a technician for a HVAC business, a childcare employee, and a chocolatier for a bakery. The program could last 1-5 years long. The length of the program will be determined, and the skills or abilities needed will be identified. It could pay for up to 144 hours of instruction per year. The apprenticeship/employer agreement is sent to the Illinois Office of Apprenticeship for approval before someone is hired.

After someone is hired, a detailed list of what you value in an employee for your business is created. Dirk provides the paperwork with information for the owner. It is editable! This is a tool to help recruit perspective employees. The Department of labor will issue credentials for the employee upon completion. There is a 90% retention rate 9 months after graduating in this program. Employees learn company culture & business goals. The program is free to set up. Once registered, you use it when it makes sense for your business, and it is your apprenticeship program. You do need to track progress periodically. It is not binding if it des not work out. The education component is very flexible from trainings, online education, or even college classes. You may have a special training school for new, improved products so that everyone has the skills they need to install or repair new models of a system.

You pay the training, and a wage is decided by the owner. You can give raises as you see skills improve or pay them just like all the other employees doing a comparable job or pay on a competency-based scale. You can give credit for previous experience or training. Dirk recommends that the apprenticeship endure for at least a year. WIO funds can help pay the salary. There is a tax credit to help with training up to \$35,000. a year. Juniors in High School can begin an apprenticeship and work a summer job and some cases after school with you. When the student graduates, then the regular apprentice job begins.


