## Speaker: Dustin Courson, Courson & Associates



Outdoor living is no longer an add-on project. They are carefully designed rooms with many spaces and features. Nearly 80% of remodelers say they designed and/or built an outdoor living

project last year in a survey from *Qualified Remodeler*.

Outdoor living is a quest for more space. There is increasing evidence that outdoor living projects have become a higher priority with customers.

Remodelers report that client interest in covered spaces such as decks, patios, porches, lanais, or sunrooms for dining purposes is stronger followed closely by extended and upgraded decks.

The top motivation for consumers seeking outdoor living spaces are consistent with the top projects typical for dining and living spaces for family and friends.

Wood decks still earn most market share of new decks each year but composite is the top choice for remodelers to specify and install.

Remodelers across the country extend living spaces to take advantage of scenic views and create opportunities for cooking as well as entertaining.

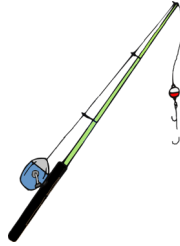

Our speaker was Jeff Houston, principal of Galesburg High School. He spoke about GAVC, The Galesburg Area Vocational Center.

They have a newly remodeled new \$2 million facility with state-of-the-art equipment including a 3-Axis CNC Shop. They are funded by the federal Perkins Grant and the state CTEI grant.

The G.A.V.C. have programs like; Building & Trades, CNC Machining, Electricity, Engineering & Design, Manufacturing, Welding and many more.

The Building & Trades students are currently building storage sheds for grade schools as their service learning projects.

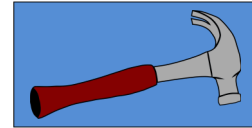

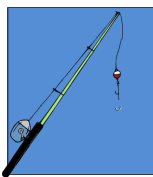
